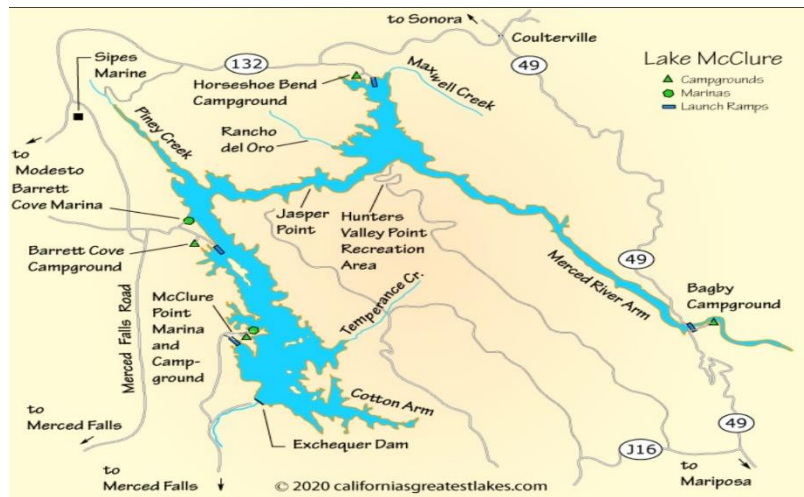

Lake McClure (Or what's left of it!)



FRESNO BASS CLUB MEMBERS,

The Fresno Bass Club was back at Lake McClure this month to finish out its 2021 regular season. The points race was tight all year and this tournament would decide who gets the 2021 AOY bragging rights.

The race was tight going into the last event. I was fortunate enough to be leading the AOY race most of the year, but I found out in October that my team partner Cory Kerber and I qualified for the Bassmaster National Team Championship at Lake Eufaula, Alabama. This qualification caused a conflict for me with our November FBC tournament and knocked me out of contention. The remaining top three anglers all had a shot at the AOY title depending upon their finishes at McClure.

The anglers that got to pre-fish for the event said the water is extremely low and that most of the lake is now a huge 5 mph zone which would make time management a crucial factor. Even with the low water conditions, the bite had been reported as great for quantity

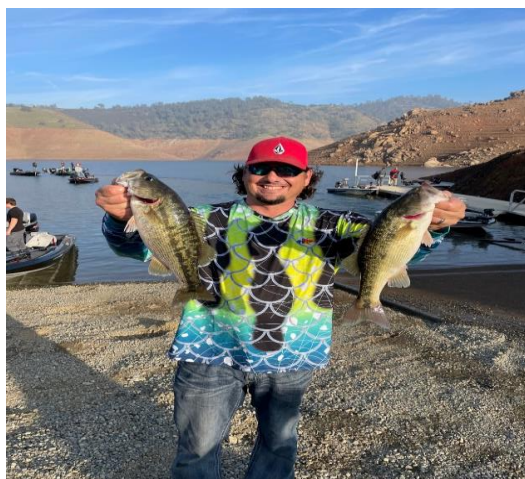
but not so much for quality. With that in mind, one good fish could make the difference been doing well or falling on your face. Add in a full moon and you might be facing some tough fishing conditions.

Well, the tough conditions didn't stop Jose Guzman from utilizing his newly purchased Ranger bass boat to rise to the top of the pack and pull out the win! Jose caught a solid five bass limit for 9.96 lbs. to take the win! His limit was anchored with a 2.38 big fish.

Jose Guzman did not get back to me in time to tell me how he caught his fish.



Second place went to the always consistent Seth Rowe. Seth weighed in another solid bag for 9.51 lbs. Seth said he fished the Temperance Creek area of the lake all day. Seth utilized a 3/8-ounce football jig and a TX rigged 6" Pro Worm in Mean Green. Seth said the majority of his fish came out of 15-30 feet. Congratulations Seth!



Third place went to Matthew Mendes who brought in five fish weighing 9.19 lbs. Matthew said he caught his fish on the main lake from 0-40 feet switching back and forth between a jig and darter head tipped with a 6" Pro Gold purple flake worm. Great Job Matt!



Fourth place went to John Albidrez who returned to the club last month and so far has been showing us that his fishing skills are still intact even though he recently turned the big 60. John's five fish limit topped the scales at 9.06 lbs. and good for a 4th place finish after cashing in last month on the tournament big fish and progressive big fish. (Maybe we didn't miss John that much?? Lol!)

John caught his fish fishing island tops with rock in 20-30 feet of water. John threw 6" Pro Worms in purple death and Pro Gold on an 1/8 oz ball head and a 1/4 Creekside jig in sculpin light. Way to go old man!



Rounding out the top five and coming off a big team tournament win at Pine Flat his son is Jessie Perez. Jessie's five fish limit weighed 9.03 lbs. with a big fish of 2.24 lbs. Jessie did not get back to me in time to post how he caught his fish.



Big fish honors for this tournament go to Eddie "big fish" Hinojosa! Eddie caught a beautiful 3.51 lbs. spotted bass on a super spook.
